1 Jesus promised that when two or three would get together in his name, then he would be with them. Let's take him at his word today, and pause to remember that he is present with us, and looks on us with love...

2 X-rays were discovered by William Röntgen from Germany, who died on this day in 1923. The discovery of X-rays (seeing deep within people) soon led to great developments in medicine. From that time on, doctors would be able to see what was below the surface of the skin without needing to perform operations to do so.

3 We are going to use for our prayer one of the psalms from the Bible. We reflect on God seeing deep within us, always looking on us with love:

4 *Let us pray:*

**Lord, lover of life,
you know the depths
of my innermost self,
and you understand me.
You protect me on every side,
shielding me from all harm.
When you put me together carefully
in my mother's womb,
you knew all about me.
I thank you for the wonder of myself
and I stand in awe
at all that you have made.
Guide me in your ways.**

(from Psalm 138/9)
