- 1 Robert Louis Stevenson was born in Edinburgh in November 1850. He is known for having written 'Treasure Island', 'Kidnapped' and 'The Strange Case of Dr Jekyll and Mr Hyde'.
- We are going to listen to 6 of the 12 points which he called his "Pattern for Living". We'll pause for a moment after each one:
- 3 "Make up your mind to be happy, and learn to find pleasure in simple things...
- 4 "Make the best of your circumstances. Noone has everything, and everyone has something of sorrow intermingled with the gladness of life. The trick is to make the laughter outweigh the tears...
- 5 "Don't take yourself too seriously. Don't think that somehow you should be protected from misfortunes that befall others...
- 6 "You can't please everybody. Don't let criticism worry you...
- 7 "Don't let your neighbour set your standards. Be yourself...
- 8 "Do the things you enjoy doing, but stay out of debt..."
- 9 Let us pray:

God our Father,
you are very pleased
when you see people living fully,
developing their talents,
living a balanced life,
and being of service to others.
We ask you to inspire us
to live as you would have us live
and walk in your presence.
Amen.
