- 5 Be praised, my Lord,
for our Brothers Wind and Air
and every kind of weather
by which you, Lord,
uphold life in all your creatures.
- 6 Be praised, my Lord, for Sister Water,
who is very useful to us,
and humble and precious and pure.
- 7 Be praised, my Lord, for Brother Fire,
through whom
you give us light in the darkness:
he is bright and lively and strong.
- 8 Be praised, my Lord,
for Sister Earth, our Mother,
who nourishes us and sustains us,
bringing forth
fruits and vegetables of many kinds
and flowers of many colours.
- 9 Be praised, my Lord,
for those who forgive for love of you;
and for those
who bear sickness and weakness
in peace and patience
- you will grant them a crown.
- 10 Be praised, my Lord, for our Sister Death,
whom we must all face.
- 11 I praise and bless you, Lord,
and I give thanks to you,
and I will serve you in all humility.
